ABOUT THE SEMINAR

This one-day seminar will provide a closer look at the debt-collection process. In particular, the seminar will cover the **Magistrate's Court Act** and new rules concentrating on consents to judgment, instituting action and enforcing judgment debts through warrants of execution; initiating financial enquiries; garnishee applications and emoluments attachment applications.

The seminar will also cover salient aspects from the **National Credit Act** in terms of categories of credit agreements; Section 129 Notices; debt review from a credit provider's perspective; suretyship agreements and charging interest and costs.

Other topics to be covered include

- latest court decisions;
- suing and executing against the State; and
- a brief look at
 - prescription of debts and proposed changes to the prescription laws; and
 - business rescue's impact on debt recovery.
