The focus of the workshop will be on practice rather than theory. Both residential and commercial evictions will be covered, with residential evictions being discussed in terms of the Prevention of Illegal Evictions from and Unlawful Occupation of Land Act 19 of 1998 (known as the PIE Act).

The programme will include:

- Commercial Evictions: High Court and Magistrate's Court;
- Residential evictions: ESTA; PIE; High Court and Magistrate's Court; action and motion procedure;
- Rental claims; and
- The Rental Housing Tribunal.
