ABOUT THIS ONE-DAY SEMINAR

In June 2007, the **National Credit Act (NCA) of 2005** replaced the South African Usury Act, 1968, and the Credit Agreements Act, 1980 to become the umbrella legislation controlling credit in South Africa. The seminar discusses the context in which the NCA operates and the significant changes it has brought about. The focus is on the latest developments, with an update on relevant case law. Topics of discussion include

- the application of the Act;
- registration requirements;
- costs of credit;
- the drafting of credit agreements;
- pleadings and debt restructuring; and
- possible amendments to the National Credit Act.

PRESENTER

Frans Haupt, director of the University of Pretoria Law Clinic, has lectured on the NCA locally and internationally. He provides training on the NCA and is often quoted in the press as a specialist on the Act.



Frans is a seasoned attorney and acts as a consultant for the Department of Trade and Industry, the National Credit Regulator, credit providers, debt counsellors and consumer organisations.
