NATIONAL CREDIT ACT | One-day seminar

The seminar will cover the most important sections of the National Credit Act (NCA) and will also highlight important court decisions over the past few years.

About this seminar

This one-day seminar focus on a brief overview of the Act, latest court decisions and/or legislative measures regarding registration requirements for credit providers, payment distribution agencies and alternative dispute resolution agents and consequences of non-compliance. Prescription in terms of the Prescription Act vs Prescription in terms of the NCA will also be unpacked. This will be followed by a discussion of possible radical amendments to the Act and the implications thereof.

Presenter

FRANS HAUPT was admitted as an attorney in 1981 and has been the director of the University of Pretoria Law Clinic since 2000. In 2013 he co-drafted the review of Government's consumer credit policy which underlies some of the subsequent amendments to the Act and regulations. He has acted as a consultant for the Department of Trade and Industry, the National Credit Regulator, various credit providers, debt counsellors and consumer organisations since the inception of

the Act. Frans has also authored and co-authored a number of reports, papers and articles both locally and internationally and has been presenting the annual update on the NCA for the Law Society of South Africa for the past eight years. He is widely regarded as an expert on the NCA.
